For this purpose, the BHS is organising a "Patient Centricity" Award, called the PACE Award.

The submission deadline is Monday December 04th 2023 (midnight CET).

The "PACE Award" jury will select one or two innovative projects on the optimisation of care for patients with blood disorders which will be awarded with a prize of up to 20.000 euro.

The winners will be personally informed before the 39th BHS General Annual Meeting, February 2-3, 2024 during which they will be invited to present their winning project in English using a visual aid.

We are looking forward to receiving outstanding projects that can change the natural history of hematological diseases.

Award Criteria

Who can apply?	\rightarrow be a member of the BHS and a natural person
	→ the project can be led by a paramedical professional practicing in a hospital setting (e.g. nurse, pharmacist, physiotherapist, social worker,) but must be supervised by a hematologist
	may not be an employee of the parmaceutical industry
Which projects are eligible?	Clinical projects focused on the optimisation of care for patients with blood disorders, both in hospital or outpatient setting (but with a link to the hospital).
