Every two years the BHS board adapts the BHS educational program in order to provide up-to-date continuous education - in compliance with the EHA CV Passport - to clinical and laboratory hematologists in training, experienced hematologists and, other interested individuals.

Seminars/courses take place on Saturday mornings at the Hof Ter Musschen on the UCL St-Luc campus in Brussels and/or digitally, but recordings on-demand and presentations are provided to trainees to allow self-studying.
