PACE AWARD

Candidates working at a pharmaceutical company are excluded.

Candidate must be a natural person, a member of the BHS, and be part of a multidisciplinary team. This team must consist of at least 3 persons, including minimum one doctor and one paramedical professional practising in a hospital setting.

WHO CAN APPLY?

Application forms are available on the BHS website www.bhs.be and must be submitted before October 31st (at midnight). Only submission through the online form is possible. Submission send by e-mail will not be considered.

- a detailed project form with a maximum of 5 pages including a budget estimate
 - a summary of maximum one page
 - an information form including the CV of project members
- The application must be written in English and must consist of

- The project must be carried out in compliance with the Protection of Privacy Law.
- The project must not fall within the definition of clinical research and may not be directly or indirectly linked to the use of a specific pharmaceutical specialty.
- Multidisciplinary clinical projects focused on the optimisation of care for patients with blood disorders, both in hospital or outpatient setting.
