Location:

Schaffhausen is a city on the Rhine in Switzerland. It is the capital of the canton Schaffhausen and has about 35.000 inhabitants. The city is located in the north of Switzerland, close to the border with Germany. Most inhabitants speak German. Schaffhausen is known for its beautiful old town and the canal cruises on the Rhine. The surroundings have a hilly landscape due to its proximity to the Jura Mountains. The city is known for the largest waterfall in Europe: the Rhine Falls, which are located a few kilometres downstream.

The secondary care hospital is one of the largest employers of the city, with over 1.500 employees. The organisation is an independent body under the public law and offers a wide variety of care to the city and its surroundings. The organisation of the hospital also includes a rehabilitation clinic and centre for psychiatric care. Annually, a total of 11.000 inpatients and 65.000 outpatients are cared for.

Job Description:

On behalf of the above-mentioned hospital, we are looking for a Haematologist for a fulltime position (0.6-1.0fte).

Within this position, leadership and further development of the department of haematology/haemato-oncology will be a major activity. You will be in close cooperation with the head of the oncology department. Furthermore, you will of course take care of in- and outpatients. This will be done in strong interdisciplinary setting. You will also take part in the continuous training of other medical professionals.

You are expected to have a completed specialist training, and thus experience, in internal medicine and hematology/hemato-oncology. Additionally, the hospital is looking for someone who has strong clinical qualifications and a high level of empathy in dealing with patients. The ability to work in a team and enjoy interdisciplinary cooperation is important. Moreover, an economic mindset will be essential to lead and assist in the further development of the department.

Good working conditions are offered. A good knowledge of the German and English language or the willingness to learn this is required. B2 level is required for registration in Switzerland, although mastery at C1 level is required in the clinic.
