

‘Luc Fraiture Prijs voor Hematologie’ ‘Luc Fraiture Award in Hematology’

Background

The ‘Luc Fraiture Award in Hematology’ is a joint initiative taken by Mr Luc Fraiture, Mr Boris Fraiture, the department of hematology of the UZ Leuven, and the Catholic University of Leuven. The goal of this initiative is to stimulate and to support scientific research in hematology in the BENELUX by funding every 3 years a research project on hematological diseases.

Current call

The current call is for projects **related to the pathogenesis of hematological disorders.**

Who can apply ?

- researchers/clinicians working in an academic institution in the BENELUX
- *and* who have obtained during the last seven years a doctoral degree in biomedical sciences on a subject related to hematology/hemato-oncology in the Benelux, France or Germany.

Budget of the Luc Fraiture Award: 10.000 €

Timelines

- launch: first of July 2014
- submission deadline: 30 September 2014
- final selection of the proposals: 15 December 2014

Procedure

- eligible candidates can apply only by using the attached forms for this ‘Luc Fraiture Award in Hematology’
- every application must meet the internationally accepted standards of high scientific quality and should be submitted in English
- all applications including the necessary attachments must be sent in electronic format to Mrs Liesbeth Celis (Liesbeth.1.celis@uzleuven.be) before October first 2014
- only complete applications will be retained for selection
- the final selection of the award winning project will be made by an expert jury panel
